

Better, safer, quicker care for you

A confidential electronic record sharing system, Share for Care, is being rolled out across Bedfordshire, Luton and Milton Keynes (BLMK).

What does this mean for me?



- Health and care professionals in Bedfordshire, Luton and Milton Keynes will be able to access relevant information about you to help them provide better, safer, quicker care.
- This includes your contact details, medical history, test results, medications, allergies and any support you've had from social care or mental health services.
- Your information will be kept confidential and secure and will only be seen by health and care professionals when they need it to provide your direct care.

If you don't want health and social care professionals from other health and care organisations in Bedfordshire, Luton and Milton Keynes to view your records, you need to contact the health or care team that provides your care.

There are currently two health and care records for residents registered with a GP practice in Bedfordshire, Luton or Milton Keynes. We plan to connect these in Spring 2023.
